- Daring to have encounters, reciprocal relationships
- Committing 1 year to build a society based on friendship with disabled and able-bodied people,
- Enjoying a worthwhile human experience before starting out in your professional life.
- Living outside of the usual routines for a time, immersing yourself in the heart of a meaningful human community.
- Coming to acquire knowledge and skills which will be of great use in your professional life (**continued education**)

Your principal assignments

- Assist the disabled people with whom you shall live with their day-to-day life.
- Be someone residents can relate to and feel safe with.
- Actively participate in all the events which mark life in the apartment (activities chosen by each resident, preparing meals, organising leisure time, etc.) and contribute to making it lively and welcoming.
- Be fully committed to life in the shared homes (parties, outings, activities, etc.)
